

2000 CRA Scorecard Bill Descriptions

BUDGET

AB 1740 Budget Act of 2000-2001. (Oppose)

EDUCATION

AB 1873 School-to-Work social engineering educational program. (Oppose)

ANTI-FAMILY/PARENT

AB 2421 Devalues marriage by giving domestic partner status to heterosexuals who "shack up." (Oppose)

AB 2142 This bill will prohibit employers or landlords from discriminating based on a person's "actual sex" or the "perception of sex." Employers like the Boy Scouts and religious book stores would be fined \$50,000 if they refused to hire transgender or cross-dressing applicants. (Oppose)

AB 2068 This bill creates a panel of experts who will develop guidelines and recommendations to identify childhood mental disorders, including screening tools for use by "parents, teachers, mental health professionals, adolescents and others. These tools can include intrusive questions about discipline, gun ownership and home stress. (Oppose)

AB 2556 This bill allows health-related services to be provided to children without parental notification or consent. (Oppose)

FIREARMS

AJR 53 A resolution asking the U.S. Congress to pass all manner of gun control programs including limiting handgun purchases and banning specific guns. (Oppose)

AB 2053 Places controls on imitation firearms (toys). (Oppose)

AB 273 Draconian handgun licensing bill. (Oppose)

HOMOSEXUAL AGENDA

AB 1931 Pro-homosexual school hate crimes bill. (Oppose)

AB 2000 Equates homosexuality with ethnic and cultural diversity. (Oppose)

AB 2418 Prohibits peremptory challenges (removal without cause) of homosexuals from jury pool. (Oppose)

AB 1785 Purpose of the bill is to shape children to not have "discriminatory attitudes" against "sexual orientation." Defines diversity as including sexual orientation. (Oppose)

AB 1326 This bill would teach children that it is hatred and bigotry to see marriage as only between a man and a woman. (Oppose)

HEALTHCARE

SB 370 This bill repeals Penal Codes that allow persons conducting ILLEGAL abortions to be prosecuted under criminal statute. With the signing of SB 370, only Civil Codes can now be used against non-licensed physicians or others who perform abortions without a license. (Oppose)

TAXES

AB 2412 Internet sales tax bill. (Oppose)

AB 1706 Assemblyman Strickland's study bill to see if reducing the sales tax on gasoline would be beneficial to the public. (Support)
