## Bill Descriptions

Bill #	Author	Description	Status
AB 17	Kehoe	Mandates that businesses contracting with the state provide domestic partner benefits to their employees.	Signed into Law
AB 76	Corbett	Known as the "sue-your-boss bill," this measure holds employers liable for the harassment of a worker by a person over whom the employer has no control, such as customers and clients.	Signed into Law
AB 94	Chu	Increases property taxes by allowing local governments to impose higher property taxes, without voter approval, in order to finance pension obligations	Vetoed
AB 196	Leno	Allows frivolous litigation against employers for refusing to hire cross-dressers or transsexuals.	Signed into Law
AB 205	Goldberg	Awards nearly all marriage benefits to domestic partners.	Signed into Law
AB 231	Steinberg	Dramatic expansion of California's welfare system. Allows Food Stamp recipients to own automobiles valued at more than \$4,650 without endangering their eligibility.	Signed into Law
AB 458	Chu	Establishes new state policy regarding gay, lesbian, bisexual, or transgender youth that are in foster care, effectively discouraging some people morally opposed to homosexuality from becoming foster parents.	Signed into Law
AB 514	Kehoe	Forces households and businesses in cities receiving water from the federal Central Valley Water Project (including Folsom, Fresno, & Roseville) to install water meters at customer expense.	Signed into Law
AB 522	Diaz	Requires that local governments honor identification cards issued by the Mexican Government (the infamous "Matricula Consular" cards).	Vetoed
AB 587	Ridley-Thomas	Requires voter registration cards to include a space where people can voluntarily list their race or ethnicity.	Signed into Law
AJR 2	Jackson	Resolution "celebrating" 30 Years of Roe v. Wade and brutal killing of millions.	Signed into Law

Bill #	Author	Description	Status
SB 2	Burton	Forces employers to purchase health insurance for their employees or pay a fee to a state healthcare fund.	Signed into Law
SB 60	Cedillo	Permits illegal aliens, felons, fugitives, "Deadbeat Dads," minors and everyone else to obtain valid California drivers licenses in whatever names they choose to provide.	Signed into Law
SB 71	Kuehl	Undermines parental rights in schools by allowing schools to ask students private questions about their sexual activity, family life, and morality without obtaining written permission from parents.	Signed into Law
SB 122	Escutia	Forces employers who are sued under the Unfair Competition Law to "disgorge" their profits to trial lawyers, even if no one was injured by their actions.	
SB 328	Escutia	Qualifies illegal aliens for free community college tuition.	Vetoed
SB 566	Scott	Allows higher local sales taxes to be imposed by local governments.	Signed into Law
AB 1765	Budget	California's disastrous State Budget for 2003-04.	Signed into Law
AB 9 5x	Budget	\$15 Billion Bond Measure	Signed into Law
